INFORMATION FOR GUIDANCE OF SAFETY BOAT CREWS

Rule 2. Minimum Requirements for Safety Boat Helm: -

- a) For Practical Sail Training (dinghy) on the River. Refer to current RCC training S&OP.
- b) For RCC dinghy racing or club organised dinghy activity on the river. Helm, aged 18 plus, holds current RYA Power Boat level 2 qualification, crew is RCC 'competent crew' assessed or under training for RCC 'competent crew' assessment.
