

Notice to Mariners

Ormonde Offshore Wind Farm – Export Cable: Diving Works

May 2017

Mariners are notified of planned diving operations works on the **Ormonde Offshore Wind Farm (OWF) export cable**. The works are planned to take place in the immediate vicinity of the Ormonde OWF Offshore Substation Platform (OSP) – see Figure 1. The dive vessel used during these works will be the *Yorkshire Lady* - see below. The bow of the vessel will be connected to the main OSP by two Poly-Ethelene/Propylene lines of up to 25 m length. The anchors at the stern of the vessel will be deployed at approximately 175 m from the vessel in a NE and SE alignment.



Planned Start Date of Dive Operations:	18 th May 2017
Planned End Date:	25 th May 2017

Mariners are requested to observe a voluntary 250m Exclusion Zone around this location and vessel during all works and also ensure that due caution is exercised at all times in these areas.


